Alsterbro Ungdomsskytte Förening



The main activities are air rifle shooting and Mauser shooting. The foundation of the association is to foster a sense of community among individuals through various activities.

Activities: Indoor shooting with air rifles at 10 meters and outdoor shooting with rifles at 50 meters.

Target Group: We welcome all children regardless of gender, age, or disability. To shoot on the outdoor range, you must be at least 11 years old or have passed the gold badge in air rifle shooting.

Cost: Membership fee is 100 SEK/year per family. Training fee is 15 SEK per session for air rifle shooting and 30 SEK per session for short-range shooting.

Equipment: All necessary equipment for participation is available for loan.

Expectations of Guardians: Parents are expected to be present during the initial sessions.

Nybro Badminton Club is a smaller, family-oriented association that focuses on teaching children and youth badminton. With us, the most important things are having fun, being a good friend, staying active, and learning new things. If you want to compete, you are of course welcome to do so.

Activities: We teach and play badminton. We have youth groups for ages 6-18 and also organize match play for seniors.

Expectations of Guardians: Support and respect your child and the club's leaders. Provide transportation to any competitions your child participates in. Help with the club's events, including planning, kiosk duty, or secretarial work.

Activities: BTK Arsenal Nybro runs a table tennis school as well as league play for children, youth, adults, and seniors.

Cost: Membership fee is 115-190 SEK/year, and participation fee is 100-350 SEK/term, depending on age.

Expectations of Guardians: Guardians of younger children are expected to participate with their child and ensure that children/teenagers have appropriate clothing.

We are an athletics club that trains year-round. There are three training groups: the Little Group, the Middle Group, and the Large Group, divided by age to tailor the training accordingly.

Activities: Athletics

Target Group: We welcome all children from 7 years and up, regardless of gender.

Cost: Membership fee for active members is 500 SEK/year. For two or more children, there is a family membership for 800 SEK/year. Support membership is 100 SEK/year.

Equipment: Regular training clothes. All other equipment is provided by the club.

Expectations of Guardians: We expect guardians to be present and assist at competitions and to show an interest in their child's involvement in our club.

Activities: Social dancing and bug courses. Kubb with training, league play, championship kubb, PRO kubb, and disability kubb. Horseshoe pitching and mini-golf. Events such as Easter walks, Santa hunts, and school relays. Try-out days for everyone. Well-established disability services.

Target Group: We cater to everyone regardless of gender, age, or any disabilities. The venue is disability-accessible.

Cost: Membership fee is 150 SEK/year for ages 0-25 and 200 SEK/year for adults. Kubb teams 400 SEK/term, horseshoe pitching 200 SEK/term. Training for kubb, horseshoe pitching, and mini-golf is 20 SEK/session. Dance courses vary depending on the course.

Equipment: All necessary equipment is available for loan on-site.

Expectations of Guardians: We provide leaders for our activities, but if guardians or assistants are needed, they must be present. There is no requirement for them to be members.

An association that runs football activities exclusively for girls and women, including children, youth, and seniors.

Activities: Girls' and women's football

Target Group: Football activities, training, and competition are available for girls from 6 years old up to women's teams. Beginners aged 6-12 years are welcome. Competitive and league play is for ages 13 and up, where prior football experience is required. Open training for beginners aged 13 and older, if there is interest and sufficient training support.

Cost: Membership fee is 200 SEK/year. Training fees range from 400 to 800 SEK/year depending on age.

Equipment: Shin guards and football shoes are needed. Some football shoes may be available for loan. Younger children trying out do not need football shoes.

Expectations of Guardians: Provide transportation to matches, assist with the kiosk during home games, and potentially serve as coaches or referees if qualified. The club sells Bingo lottery tickets at Christmas and socks or other items in the fall or spring to raise funds for the activities. As a non-profit organization, everyone is expected to contribute.

Activities: Nybro IF offers football for children, youth, adults, and football for individuals with disabilities, including children, youth, and adults.

Target Group: Children and youth aged 5-16 years. Primarily for boys, but girls are also welcome at younger ages. Para-football for children, youth, and adults. Senior football for men.

Cost: Membership fee is 100 SEK/year. The training fee depends on the age group, starting from 200 SEK/year.

Equipment: Football shoes and shin guards are the required personal equipment. Football shoes are available for loan at the club.

Expectations of Guardians: Guardians are expected to be engaged and support their children in the activity. The association holds events/tournaments where guardians are expected to help with kiosks, secretarial work, and more. There is no requirement to sell items as we are a lottery-free association.

Nybro Riding Club is a non-profit association with around 330 members. It serves as a hub for sustainable equestrian activities in the municipality and surrounding area.

Activities: Basic and advanced training for all types of riders and horses, including both riding and horse handling.

Target Group: Riding is available for everyone regardless of gender or age. To enroll in the riding school, a child must be at least 4 years old.

Cost: Membership fee is 350 SEK/year for those under 18 and 450 SEK/year for those 18 and older. Riding fees range from 175 to 600 SEK per lesson, depending on age, level of training, number of participants in the lesson, whether riding alone, and so forth.

Equipment: Helmet, safety vest, and specific riding shoes. These are available for loan.

Expectations of Guardians: Initially, we expect guardians to be present in the stable and spectator areas. Assistance is also needed during workdays, in the café, for selling goods twice a year, and as officials at competitions.
